

DATE FOR 2009 CAMP: JULY 12– JULY 18

The purpose of our camp is the re-creation of the campers. Their minds and bodies are refreshed through Bible study and recreation in God's beautiful nature world. **Our motto** is from Colossians 3:17— "Whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it in the name of the Lord Jesus." Our **specific objectives** are (1) to deepen our young people's knowledge and faith through Bible study, (2) to develop their faith-lives of service, and (3) to build Christian friendship and fellowship.

Enrollment is open to children and teens from our congregations. *Juniors* are girls and boys entering grades 4-6. *Intermediates* are those entering grades 7-8. *Seniors* are confirmed young people entering grades 9-12, or just out of grade 12. *Little Lambs* are children of counselors and other staff below grade 4. Each group has its own activities and study program.

Rates for the 2009 camp are: \$375 for the first child in a family, \$245 for each additional child, and \$120 for each Little Lamb aged 4-7 (3 & under are free). **Snack bar cards** are available in \$5 and \$10 denominations, with a \$15 maximum per camper. We recommend at most \$10 for Juniors and Intermediates. Unused portions will be refunded at the end of Camp. Campers with snack bar cards do not need money during the week, and we discourage bringing it. Senior applicants (grade 9th-12th) should add \$5 to their camper fee for the cost of their special Friday Night Festivities. Senior campers will also be taking an overnight field trip, which may involve water activities, including boating. Parents-please sign the permission statement on the registration form for your senior camper. Also: Camp Tee shirts for all ages can be ordered @ \$10 each. Please include size & fee with your application.

Can't afford it? First ask your pastor if help is available from your congregation. Congregations whose members need additional assistance should have their pastor contact the camp business manager. We have some scholarship funds available.

Applications including tee shirt orders (together with medical form and fees) are due by May 15th. *Forms and fees without shirt orders are due by June 25th.* Make checks payable to *Tree of Life Lutheran Bible Camp, Inc.*, and mail to Timothy Mann, Camp Business Manager, 518 Channing Ave., Palo Alto, CA 94301.; phone (650)-853-1304 (evening) or (650)-427-1771 (day).; email: camp@tim-mann.org. **Please do not mail staff registration forms to this address.** Late registrations are usually accepted, depending on space available. Please telephone Mr. Mann if your application will be late.

Camp opens Sunday, July 12 at 6:00pm. You can register any time between 6 - 7:00pm. **No meal will be served on this evening.** Late arrivals must check in with Camp Director. Orientation begins at 7:00 pm. **Camp closes** Saturday July 18 at 11:00am. Please pick up your children promptly.

Camp grounds are in the Sierra foothills at 2500 ft. elevation. Air temperatures can vary from hot to cool: campers should pack accordingly. The grounds are shaded by evergreens and deciduous trees. **Facilities** include cabins and bunkhouses; showers, a dining hall and meeting rooms; hiking trails, playfield, volleyball & basketball courts, and an on-site swimming pool.

Camp is located off Interstate 80 about 15 miles east of Auburn. Take Interstate 80 to the Weimar Cross Road exit. Exit on the ramp, then turn right (nearly 180 degrees) onto Ponderosa Way. Turn left off of Ponderosa Way at the first opportunity (less than a block), onto East Weimar Cross Road. Follow this road until its end, about 5 miles. **Camp mailing address** is Capital Mountain Christian Camp, 2550 East Weimar Cross Road, PO Box 1118, Weimar, CA 95736; phone 530-637-5368.

Staff includes the camp director, Bible study instructors, counselors, activities director, handicrafts director and assistants. Counselors are adult members of our congregations, approved by their pastor, who supervise up to ten campers each. **Activities include:** swimming, basketball, volleyball, softball and other field games, archery, cabin relays, Kids Olympics, and various fellowship activities and games. A **Nurse** and **lifeguard** are provided. All campers and staff are covered by **accident insurance**. Cabin skits are encouraged for Skit Night (typically Thursday evening at 7:30). Parents are welcome.

Camp regulations and the daily schedule will be followed. Cabin assignments are made prior to camp and are **final**. If special arrangements are necessary, please indicate on the application. Shaving cream, electronic games, comic books, BB or pellet guns, and skateboards are not permitted. Each cabin is allowed one radio/tape player, for quiet play of God pleasing lyrics during morning wake-up and evening wind-down times only, under control of the counselor. Public displays of romantic affection are not allowed.

All medications coming to camp must be kept and administered by the camp nurse. Label medication with the camper's name and exact instructions, and check it in with the nurse after registration. Please check your child for head lice before camp.

We are legally incorporated in the State of California, with a seven-member board of directors drawn from our sponsoring churches. We ask each church to send an official representative to our annual meeting; others interested in the camp are also welcome at this and other meetings.

The undersigned, for himself or herself and personal representatives, assigns, heirs and the next of kin (herein referred to as releasers) hereby releases, waives, discharges, and covenants not to sue Capital Mountain Christian Camp, its owners, agents, servants, or employees (herein referred to as releasees) from all liability to releasers for all loss or damage and any claim or demands on account of injury to the person or property or resulting death of the releasers, whether caused by negligence of releasees or otherwise while participating in activities associated with camp. The undersigned is fully aware of the inherent hazards and hereby elects to participate voluntarily and assumes all risk of loss, damage or injury that may be sustained by him or her.

The undersigned has read and voluntarily signs this medical release and waiver of all liability and assumption of risk agreement.

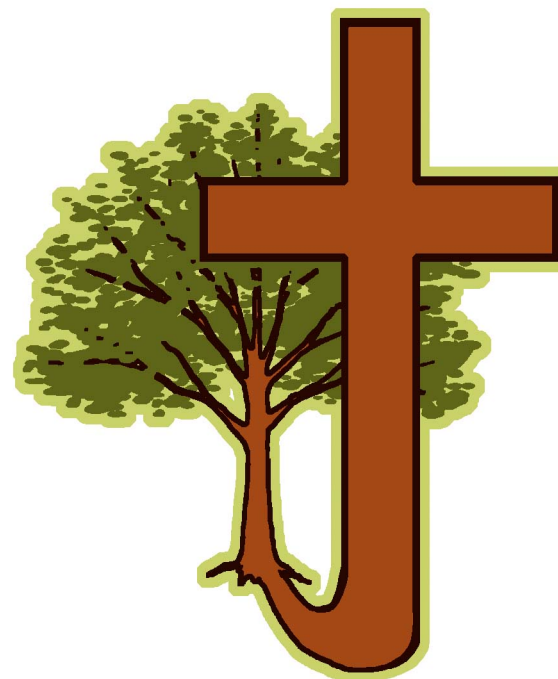
